

Vegetarian, gluten-free and reduced salt/sugar options are offered at every meal, and with the variety of selection, there's always something for every guest.


An assortment of items are available 24/7. Guests with food allergies or dietary restrictions are asked to see the front desk to fill-out a dietary form.

# **AMENITIES**

#### **Shared Washroom Dorms**

For guests who are staying in rooms with shared washrooms, please be assured that all shared amenities are cleaned and sanitized daily using procedures that are aligned with Alberta Health Services guidelines. Additional cleaning and sanitation supplies are provided for your comfort within each room.

#### TV & Internet Access / Use

All rooms have a TV with free cable.

Internet access is available via direct connection only (no wireless available). CAT5e cables may be purchased from vending machines

# Laundry

Laundry machines, located in each wing, are available for complimentary use between the hours of 5:00 AM and 10:00 PM.

Work coveralls or outerwear are not permitted to not be laundered in the machines.

# **SAFETY AND SECURITY**

# **Emergency**

An emergency evacuation plan is posted on the back of the door in each room and at the entrance and exit to each building. Please familiarize yourself with your closest exit.

In case of an emergency evacuation: exit the lodge and go to the muster point identified on the plan, closest to you, and wait for further instruction. Guests are asked to remain at the muster point until the all-clear is given by Emergency Services or Security.

# **Sharps**

Sharps containers must be used in disposing sharp objects, needles and pointed items. Sharps containers can be found in public washroom, laundry and Front Desk. Failure to properly dispose sharps may result in the loss of lodge privileges.

# Examples of sharps:

- Hypodermic/blunted needles
- Razors and razor blades
- X-Acto knives
- Scissors
- In addition to needles and blades, anything attached to them, such as syringes and injection devices, is also considered sharps waste

# **Smoking**

Smoking is only permitted in designated smoking areas. Failure to do so may result in disciplinary measures. Thank you for your cooperation.

# Wildlife

Due to the remote location of our operations there is a potential to encounter dangerous wildlife such as bears, cougars and other animals. Precautions have been taken to limit the risk of these encounters

The wildlife were here first, you are in THEIR territory. Please show respect for any wild animal you encounter for your safety and for theirs. In the event of a wildlife sighting, please inform the Front Desk.

Additionally, here is what you can do to keep yourself and others safe:

- Secure garbage bins
- Do not prop open doors
- Do not feed, tease or provoke wildlife at any time
- Avoid traps set for wildlife

# **Speed Limits**

The speed limit of this site is 30km/hr and is monitored by our Security team to ensure the safety of everyone. Vehicles parked on site and left unattended for a period exceeding 90 days may be towed away at the owner's expense.
